

Secondary School Supply List For Students in Grades 6 through 12 2023-2024 School Year

Below is a list of supplies that students will need for the start of the school year. Additional supplies might be required later in the year, depending on the learning style of the student and the selection of courses taken.

Suggested specifications: Apple Macbook Air or Macbook Pro with 13" display, 8GB ram, 256GB SSD storage, supporting latest macOS version.









Physical Education Supplies

Using a School Instrument

Students are encouraged to have their own band instruments, but the school provides a limited selection of instruments for loan, free of charge. Available instruments include flutes, clarinets, saxophones, trumpets, French horns, trombones, and baritone horns. No string instruments are available. Percussion instrument students must have their own mallets and practice instrument. Students/parents are responsible for the care and maintenance of loaned instruments. Please discuss with the music teacher at the start of the school year if interested.
